The Night the Lights Went Out

Last month I wrote that the General Fund, Piers and Harbors, and Pool Budgets would be published in this issue of the Sea Breeze. As we were discussing the budgets at our December Board Meeting, we suddenly lost power. Except for a small emergency light in the hallway there was only darkness. Due to a main trunk line failure, this was an all Community power outage complete with flashing blue and green arcs of light emanating from the general direction of Parole and on the eve of the Mayan Calendar prediction that the world would end. Fortunately, the world did not end, but neither were all of the Budgets approved. This is a requirement before they are presented to the Community and published in the Sea Breeze.

They will be presented to the Board at our next meeting, and presented to the Community at the General Meeting on March 14, 2013. Publication will follow in the April Sea Breeze.

Members of the Board of Directors and Committee Members will be present to answer your questions and process your forms and payments and generally assist in all of the activities required to make CAGID run smoothly. Despite Increase, Community Pool Still a Bargain

The Board of Directors approved an increase in the fees for the 2013 pool season. The increase is consistent with the increasing costs of operating the pool. In addition, we have a new expense this year to meet the requirements of "Connor's Law". The law mandates all pools have a defibrillator and trained operators available. The necessary equipment purchase will result in approximately 3% increase in our operating budget for this year.

I sometimes forget that the recreational opportunities that we enjoy in Hillsmere did not just happen. They evolved through the hard work of many volunteers willing to undertake major and minor, but important, projects. If you are serving alcohol at your party, you will need to obtain an Anne Arundel County One-Day Liquor License. Signed application forms for a liquor license must be obtained from HSIA and submitted to the County as least two weeks prior to the event.

New for 2013:

Slip Waiting List – A onetime, non-refundable fee of \$100 is now required to remain on or be added to the slip waiting list. The fee will be applied to your slip rental when you are assigned a slip. Individuals on the wait list will no longer be required to sign up annually to maintain their position on the list. **If you are currently on the list payment of the \$100 must be received by February 23rd, 2013 (CAGID) or you will be removed from the list.**

Continuing in 2013:

Photocopy of ALL registrations required: HSIA will give you one sticker for each vehicle and trailer registration you provide along with your membership form. Please attach your photocopy to the HSIA membership form and bring it with you on Come & Get It Day.

Slip Renters - You received a membership form with your invoice. Please bring both the invoice and membership form to Come And Get It Day, or return both in the mail. **You MUST submit photocopies of your current Maryland boat registration and boat insurance policy. Boat titles are only needed if we do not have one on file. These documents MUST be submitted along with the slip rent payment. PAYMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS.**

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Security Report

We recently increased the scope of our security patrol. In addition to watching homes for vacationers, monitoring school bus stops and patrolling community property, security is going to begin checking the homes of the elderly and those needing assistance. During patrols, the guard will stop and physically check on the well being of residents. Please let security know if you would like to be added or have a relative that should be added by emailing, calling or stopping the guard during his patrols. Please provide, name, address, phone number, and emergency contact.

Since the last *Sea Breeze*, the community has had a car break-in and car vandalism. Be diligent by locking your vehicles and homes to help keep the community safe. Small crimes can lead to larger ones, so report all suspicious persons to the police. Your efforts could help a neighbor. Remember, a suspicious person can be anyone - resident or non-resident. When calling the police, you can remain anonymous.

I constantly receive complaints about speeding cars throughout the neighborhood. Remember, Hillsmere has a large number of children, so slow it down and remind other drivers of the same. I have requested AACO police to run traffic control to help with this issue.

Another repeated complaint is the issue of dogs at the beach. These people know who they are, and in my opinion they have no respect for beach rules and other residents of the neighborhood. So if you see a dog or pet, remind the owner the beach is a pet-free area.

Remember to get your 2013 community stickers (Come and Get it Day is February 23) as security and AACO police will be enforcing them. The community stickers help AACO police and security to identify residents vs. non-residents. You may be approached and questioned by police or security if you do not display a current sticker.

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Crystal Spring Development update

While the HSIA Board has no official position regarding the proposed Crystal Spring Development on Forest Drive at Spa Road, we urge you to be informed and contact Annapolis City and Anne Arundel County Officials to voice any concerns.

The project developer will file its application in a couple of months. The Annapolis Planning Commission will then hold public hearings to decide if the project's density or design is accepted, must be altered, or is denied.

If this project concerns you, please write Mayor Josh Cohen and our County Council representative Chris Trumbauer.

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Piers and Harbor News

The New Year has begun without starting the main pier renovation project. I know that I am not alone in being frustrated by the length of time required to secure a commercial loan to begin this project. By now we had hoped to be more than half way done. We are told by the loan officer that the delays were caused by [a veritable perfect storm of] loan activity - excessive volume from the looming Fiscal Cliff, loans resulting from Hurricane Sandy and lots of new rules and paperwork for banks to collect before closing a loan. But, despite a drop dead date of 11 January, we were successful in closing on the loan on that day. Contracts have been signed for all the contractors and we expect work to begin in late January.



Pier Renovation

As a refresher, this project will involve removal/replacement of ~135 foot existing dock from the seawall out to approximately slip 51a, and all associated electrical and plumbing infrastructure. We are approaching this as a 30 year life cycle replacement. When construction begins, the area will be fenced off to limit access. After the work day and on weekends, the fencing will be adjusted to allow limited access to the beach and pier.

During the renovation the outer slips will not be accessible by land and all power/water service for the entire dock will be secured. The Slips committee has done a great job orchestrating boat movements to find slips for those who will remain at the dock over the winter.

This project is starting late – there is no question. We believe that with good weather, this project may be complete by the First of April. However, as with most large projects, hope for the best and plan for the worst. This means, from a scheduling stand point, I don't recommend planning to use your slips for recreational purposes before mid-April if your slip is located on the outer docks. However, with the exception of the ~15 slips directly affected by the project, it is likely that you will be able to place your boats in your slips. But, you should plan on having restricted walking access and no water or electricity until the project has been completed and inspected by the county. Please communicate with the Slips committee as early as possible for your slip needs. We'll do our best accommodating everyone to the best of our ability.

Slip Waiting List

The HSIA Board has approved a \$100 fee for Slip Wait List'ers. Currently there are over 100 people on this list. Last year the Slips committee contacted, on average, three "Wait List'ers" to fill a single slip. The take-away from this, in my opinion, is that that most people on the Wait List are not serious about having a slip, and unnecessarily complicates the Slip Committee's job. The intent of the fee is to reward those who are serious about having a slip with a shorter list, thereby reducing the time to get you in the water. If you are wondering about this being a new fee, in fact, it is not a new fee. It is being restored after a 10-years hiatus, and is at the same rate.

It is important to note that this fee is not refundable, but, it will be applied to your first year's slip fee. Also, neglecting to renew your HSIA membership triggers a loss of your spot on the list, and the \$100 deposit. Lastly, all existing rules regarding rejecting an offer for a slip remain unchanged. If you have rejected an offer twice in the past and reject a third time this year, you will be moved to the bottom of the list.

Under-usage of Slips

Last year we identified 27 slips that appear to be under-used, meaning there has not been a boat in the slip all season. A number people wrote to us in response; thank you for your quick responses. There are also a number of boats that appear to be severely neglected. This is unfortunate in the extreme. If you are one of these slip holders or boat owners, please communicate your intentions for next season. Don't forget, there are 100 people on the wait list who would love to "use" that space.

Boat Park and Kayak Rack Rules

One of the last items the late Fred Hickman accomplished as Steering committee chairperson was rewriting the Boat Park rules to more closely match the Rules for the main pier, and the first edition of Kayak Rules. These rules have been submitted to the HSIA Board for approval at the January meeting. Once approved, they will be mailed to everyone renting space in the Boat Park and Kayak Racks.

- Family Memberships will receive a minimum of 4 Membership Cards.
- Family Memberships with fewer than four members will receive a combination of Membership Cards and Season Guest Passes to total four cards.
- **Early Bird Bonus:** For memberships purchased on or before CAGID, Family Memberships will receive five free member guest passes and Adult Memberships will receive two free member guest passes.

Required Supporting Documents for HSIA Membership and use of HSIA Properties

In an effort to ensure that our community facilities are properly used and to protect the interests of our residents, we now require certain supporting documents when applying for HSIA membership or when receiving a slip in our marina. **Please submit a photocopy** of the supporting documents along with your application. To protect your privacy, you may black out personal information. Refer to the table below to see what information must be readable.

Document	Required By	Explanation
Driver's License or other proof of residency.	Renters or other persons not on the tax records.	Any resident over 18 or any property owner is eligible to join HSIA. We are able to check tax records online to verify listed property owners. Renters or anyone else not listed on the tax records must provide proof of residency. Name and address must be readable.
Vehicle Registration	Anyone requesting a Hillsmere sticker.	A copy of the current vehicle registration is required for EACH VEHICLE for which you are requesting a sticker. Tag number, make/model, name, and address must be readable.
Trailer Registration	Anyone requesting a boat ramp key and trailer sticker. Note: All trailers using the boat ramp are required to have Hillsmere stickers.	A copy of the current trailer registration is required for EACH TRAILER for which you are requesting a sticker. Since Maryland law requires all boat trailers be registered, no stickers will be issued for non-registered trailers. Tag number, name, and address must be readable.
USCG Documentation or MD Boat Registration; AND Boat Title	Anyone receiving a slip in the marina.	A copy of the boat's title, and the current USCG documentation or MD boat registration (if not documented) is required for any boat receiving a slip in the marina. All owners must be listed. See the marina rules for percent ownership requirements.
HSIA Boat Ownership Form	Anyone receiving a slip for a boat that has multiple owners.	This document describes the percentage ownership for each owner of a boat that is receiving a slip in the marina. It must be signed by each owner of the boat. All signatures must be notarized.
Boat Insurance Policy Declarations Page	Anyone receiving a slip in the marina.	A copy of the current boat insurance policy declarations page is required for any boat in the marina. See the marina rules for the required coverage and limits of liability.

HSIA does not release any information provided with the membership application or supporting documents to any third party. All reasonable efforts are made to protect the information submitted. If you have any questions or concerns about providing the required information and documents please contact HSIA.

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
An HSIA Building Permit is required every time an Anne Arundel Co. Building Permit is required.

The responsibility of obtaining an HSIA Building Permit does not fall on your builder, it falls on you.

The following items are needed to obtain an HSIA Building Permit:

1. A copy of the Anne Arundel County Building Permit.
2. A copy of the construction location on the property when required by the County.
3. Cash or check in the amount of \$5.00 made payable to HSIA, unless we sent you a certified letter. If a Certified Letter is required, the cost is \$20 for the permit.
4. Mail to HSIA, P.O. Box 3485, Annapolis, MD 21403

Permits are required for construction of new houses, new sheds, additions to houses or sheds, retaining walls, piers and bulkheads. When in doubt, or if you have any questions, please call the HSIA Building Permit Chairperson, Bill Anderson, at 410-263-4456.
