#### Regular Meeting of the HSIA Board of Directors, Meeting Summary

Please go to www.hillsmereshores.net to read complete meeting minutes.

#### The following motions were approved by a majority of the Directors present:

#### **BEACH:**

**Kathy McFadden motioned** the Board approve \$5000 of Special Tax funds to complete shoreline stabilization measures at the storm water/swale outfall in accordance with design specifications provided by Near Shore Engineering. Kathy further motioned that the Board authorizes the President to execute a contract with Grass Roots, Inc. to complete the work as specified. Helene Raven seconded the motion. Vote taken – 8 in favor; 1 abstained (Steve Vanderbosch). Motion approved.

#### **PIERS & HARBOR:**

**Steve Vanderbosch motioned** the Board approve a purchase order to Jones of Annapolis for the delivery and gate-spreading of gravel on the travel lanes and parking areas of the Sand Spit, as needed. Estimate between two and four truckloads of gravel may be needed. \$540/truckload; NTE \$2200 from Special Tax funds. Kathy McFadden seconded the motion. Vote taken – unanimously approved.

**Steve Vanderbosch motioned** the Board approve up to \$2000 Piers & Harbor funds for the acquisition of up to 40 6' recycled rubber wheel stops with spikes for installation along the bulkhead at the marina to help prevent damage to utilities and create a safer walkway. Suzanne Martin seconded the motion. Vote taken – unanimously approved.


**Steve Vanderbosch motioned** the Board approve \$1100 for electrical repair at the marina. Suzanne Martin seconded the motion. Vote taken – unanimously approved.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Helene Raven motioned** the Board create a special committee, composed of the Treasurer and two other Board Members, to clarify the issue of public vs. private community property. The committee can spend up to \$3000 on legal fees. The committee will prepare an article for *the Sea Breeze* with an explanation. All community rules will remain unchanged until the issue is clarified and published. Mark Carroll seconded the motion. Discussion. Motion Withdrawn.







#### **BUILDING PERMITS**

An HSIA Building Permit is required: Every time an Anne Arundel County Building Permit is required. The responsibility of obtaining an HSIA Building Permit does not fall on your builder, it falls on you.

The following items are needed to obtain an HSIA Building Permit:

- 1. A copy of the Anne Arundel County Building Permit.
- 2. A copy of the construction location on the property when required by the County.
- 3. Cash or check in the amount of \$5.00 made payable to HSIA, unless we sent you a certified letter. If a Certified Letter is required, the cost is \$20 for the permit.
- 4. Mail to HSIA, P.O. Box 3485, Annapolis, MD 21403

Permits are required for construction of new houses, new sheds, additions to houses or sheds, retaining walls, piers and bulkheads. When in doubt, or if you have any questions, please call the HSIA Building Permit Chairperson, Bill Anderson, at 410-279-1666.

#### **More New Slip Holders!**

We are pleased to welcome 2 more new Slip Holders to the Hillsmere Marina: Tim Edney and Jon Gray. Bill Barker's Slips Committee continues to do a great job in keeping the Marina full. We will be surveying the Marina in June to see if any slips are not yet occupied and determine why. Please ensure your 2015 HSIA Marina sticker is visible on your boat. There may be one or two slips available to rent for just the season. Look for an email notification.

#### **Marina Improvements**

The Sand Spit has been resurfaced with a layer of gravel and the driveway pot holes patched. New entrance, Marina, and new speed limit sign (still 5 MPH!) have been posted. New landscaping and picnic tables (courtesy of Hillsmere Pool) have been upgraded. Winter debris removed from the bulkhead area and ten pier pedestal lights and receptacles repaired (thanks to Norm Johansen and George Miller!). Holding tank risers installed. And still in progress: Gate key cards, speed bumps, curb stops, and continuation of power washing the piers.

#### **Guest Passes, Parking, Towing**

Guest parking passes issued last year for 2014-15 are still valid. **Be sure your vehicle displays a current 2015 HSIA vehicle sticker**, and that your guests display a Guest Pass in their vehicles. The HSIA Board has authorized towing of vehicles from the Marina parking area if the vehicles do not display an appropriate sticker or Guest Pass. The HSIA Security Guard will be manning the entrance to the Marina on a periodic basis this year.

#### Tying Up In Your Slip






Please check your lines frequently, and especially before and after storms. Use spring lines to control fore and aft movement. Put fenders out where your boat is likely to come in contact with the pier or pilings. Please use chafing guards where your mooring lines cross over finger piers. An ounce of prevention is worth hundreds of dollars in cure.

#### **P&H Meeting Time and Place**

## **Dumpster Days**

Dumpster Days are scheduled for our community on Friday and Saturday, July 17 and 18. The dumpsters will be located adjacent to the community pool. The dumpsters will be delivered by noon on Friday, July 17 and removed by 1:30 pm on Saturday, July 18. Please make sure the dumpsters are in place before hauling any items to the dumpster area. If we have a large amount of rain, dumpsters could be relocated to the beach parking lot.

Please be courteous and follow all directions to maintain a smooth flow of traffic. We will be using a clockwise traffic pattern, the same as in previous years (please see map on next page). To avoid excessive damage to the grounds, do not enter or exit the dumpster area from Harbor Drive. If anyone can volunteer to help supervise loading of the dumpsters or the flow of traffic, please call the HSIA voice mail at 410-263-4456.

#### The following items are prohibited:

Garbage or similar trash, hazardous materials, tires, liquids, pressurized containers, refrigerators, air conditioners, boats, trailers, logs or tree trunks.

#### Please follow these guidelines:

Do not bring children.

Watch for, and do not interfere with, County trucks and bulldozers in the area.

Do not leave waste materials outside the dumpsters or allow them to protrude above the top of the container.

Do not put too much heavy material in one container. Fill the containers completely from the rear to the front.


Tie or bundle light material so it won't blow around. Disassemble large items such as swing sets and other similar items. Cut tree trimmings into 3-4 foot lengths.

Do not put material into the containers after dark.

Do not block flow of local traffic on Great Lake Drive.

## Swim Safe: Operation Clearwater Bacteria Monitoring is now underway. Download the App for instant access to clarity results!

The South River Federation (SRF) takes weekly water samples from the Hillsmere Beach, along with other beaches and tests for bacteria levels. The acceptable concentration of bacteria for safe swimming & direct water contact is 104 cfu (colony forming units) per 100 ml. Anne Arundel County has a 48 hour no swimming/recreational guidance of waterways after a rain event. Results will be published throughout the summer in *the Sea Breeze*, and can also be found at the SRF website: <a href="http://www.southriverfederation.net/index.php/our-programs/water-quality/bacteria-data">http://www.southriverfederation.net/index.php/our-programs/water-quality/bacteria-data</a>. Go to the SRF website to download a mobile app that will help you access the information. The test results for May 20, 2015 at the Hillsmere Community Beach was 20 cfu/100ml. Please note that results along the river indicated elevated bacteria due to a recent thunderstorm.


