HSIA Election Voting Instructions

Vote By Mail or Email: If you are unable to drop off your ballot in person at the Community House at 119 Great Lake Drive on November 12, please follow these simple steps in order to vote by mail or email.

1. Tear the ballot out of the Sea Breeze or download a copy from the web site.
2. Fill out the election ballot.
3. You **must** include your name, address, date, and signature in the space provided on the ballot.
4. Mail the signed ballot to **HSIA, PO Box 3485, Annapolis, MD 21403**. Be sure to mark "Ballot" on the envelope. Or scan and email your signed ballot to nominations@hillsmereshores.org
5. Ballots must be received prior to November 12.

Vote In Person: Please note: If you are voting in person, there is no need to provide your name, address, date, and signature on the ballot.

1. Tear the ballot out of the Sea Breeze, download a copy from the web site, or pick up a ballot at the community house.
2. Have your ballot validated upon arrival. You do **NOT** need to mark your selections before the ballot is validated.
3. Please be prepared to show a picture ID.
4. Drop ballots in the ballot box.
5. Please remember that masks are required and social distancing guidelines are in place.

Note: You may have someone else drop off your completed, signed ballot at the Community House by following steps 1, 2, and 3 in the **Vote by Mail** section above.
