HSIA Election Voting Instructions

Vote By Mail or Email: If you are unable to attend the November 10 HSIA General Meeting, , please follow these simple steps in order to vote by mail or email.

1. Tear the ballot out of the Sea Breeze or download a copy from the web site.
2. Fill out the election ballot.
3. You **must** include your name, address, date, and signature in the space provided on the ballot.
4. Mail the signed ballot to **HSIA, PO Box 3485, Annapolis, MD 21403 or drop it in the community dropbox at 119 Great Lake Drive**. Be sure to mark "Ballot" on the envelope. Or scan and email your signed ballot to nominations@hillsmereshores.org
5. Ballots must be received prior to November 10.

Vote In Person: Please note: If you are voting in person, there is no need to provide your name, address, date, and signature on the ballot.

1. Tear the ballot out of the Sea Breeze, download a copy from the web site, or pick up a ballot at the General meeting.
2. Have your ballot validated upon arrival at the meeting. You do **NOT** need to mark your selections before the ballot is validated.
3. Drop ballots in the ballot box.

Note: You may have someone else drop off your completed, signed ballot at the General Meeting by following steps 1, 2, and 3 in the **Vote by Mail** section above.
